

We plan to operate during the 2020-2021 academic year with proactive policies and precautions to prevent the spreading of germs, viruses, and illnesses. *

The following practices will be in place:

- 1. During orientation all students and staff will take a COVID-19 awareness/safety training to enhance our ability to maintain a clean environment.
- 2. Class sizes will be limited to 16 students maximum. All meals will be eaten in classrooms.
- 3. Dance/Art areas will have air purifiers installed. (Masks will not be used during physical activity but will be used in common spaces, classrooms and in dance spaces while non active)
- 4. Temperatures will be taken via a touch free thermometer at the start of each day.
- 5. Hand washing upon entry of the building and before lunch time.
- 6. Classrooms/workstations will be sanitized between uses and at the end of each day.
- 7. Sanitizing stations will be set up in each room (Monthly Commercial Cleaning).
- 8. Each student will receive a clip on personal sized hand sanitizer for their back pack at orientation in addition to two school issued face masks.
- 9. Children who don't feel well are asked to complete school work from home (please refer to the student handbook for attendance reporting procedures).
- 10. Disposable 3ply masks/face shields will be made available for anyone who needs one.
- 11. We will practice social distancing while encouraging a continuous coworking environment by using alternative seating such as large tables for group assignments.
- 12. When the weather permits, outdoor face mask breaks will be taken.
- 13. If necessary, students will be mandated to distance learning only.
